Updating SQLWorks Automatically

When you attempt to log in, your client will be checked to ensure it is currently operating on the latest version of SQLWorks.

If a new update is available, you will be presented with a window detailing the Method through which the update will be deployed, the Source location it will be downloaded from, and the Target destination on your system for the update's deployment.

From here, you can either click Update SQLWorks to begin the update or click Cancel to stop the update and return to the Sign-In screen.

- You can also click Info to view any further information about the current update.

Updating SQLWorks Manually

In addition to automatic updates, you can also initiate a manual update in one of two ways:

1. On the login screen, you can perform an update by navigating to the Session tab on the login window and clicking the Update button.
 - a) Select Update SQLWorks on the pop-up box



2. If you are currently logged into SQLWorks, you can perform an update by navigating to SQLWorks 2020 and clicking Update SQLWorks from Server.
 - Note that performing an update will end your current SQLWorks session and return you to the login screen, so ensure that any important work in the client is saved before doing so.
